Fact Sheet

- Application must be submitted online before **October 17, 2014 at 5pm Central Standard Time.**
- Applicants must work in a public library with a demonstrated need and capacity to address the diverse backgrounds within its community, specifically for children from birth to age 14.
- Applicants must be able to attend the ALSC Diversity Forum taking place at the American Library Association's Midwinter Meeting in Chicago on Friday, January 30, 2015. Awardees will receive a \$500 travel stipend to attend.
- Applicants must be a current personal member of ALSC. To become an ALSC member [click here for more information](#).
- Applicants must be located within 20 miles of a Dollar General Store, distribution center, or corporate office (please visit Dollar General's Store Locator at <http://www.dollargeneral.com/storeLocator>).
- Up to 20 applicants will be chosen.
- Awarded applicants will receive \$1,500 to be used to implement a Día program(s) in their community that focuses on diversity and STEAM. Grant funds can be used to purchase books to be given to participants or added to collections, purchase program supplies, for program outreach and other activities as deemed appropriate.
- All funded libraries are required to complete all reporting requirements for this grant prior to June 1, 2015; including online mid-term and final reports and correspondence with ALSC staff and/or contractor regarding program activities.
